ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PENINSULA WOMEN'S CHORUS, A CALIFORNIA PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION

ONE: The name of this corporation is Peninsula Women's Chorus.

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are to foster and financially support the development of musical talents and skills and support musicianship among women of the San Francisco Peninsula, and to present quality concerts featuring music for women's voices.

THREE: The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Ruthellen Dickinson, 962 Van Auken Circle, Palo Alto, CA 94303.

- FOUR: (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (b) The primary objectives and purposes of this corporation are:
 - 1. To foster, cultivate, and financially support the development of musical talents and

skills and encourage and support musicians and musicianship among women of the San Francisco Peninsula.

- 2. To present quality concerts featuring music composed specifically (or arranged primarily) for women's voices, thus promoting musical and artistic advancement of the community to hear good music and musicianship.
- 3. To foster and cultivate the musical education interests of the chorus.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (d) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

SIX: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes meeting the requirements of Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and no part of the net income or assets

of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes meeting the requirements of Section 214 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
